When you need help the most, you don't want to wait for a doctor's calendar to open.

Well, there is a new provider in town hoping to cut out those long waits.

The Payson Walk-In Clinic is a new provider for healthcare in Rim Country. The goal is to provide care more like it used to be. With Western hospitality and same-day, walk-in care, patients can count on the Payson Walk-In Clinic for better, faster, and more affordable primary healthcare services, according to its owners.

Steve Borak, a nurse practitioner with a focus on family health care, leads the clinic. He said he is passionate about providing an alternative option to traditional clinic care and dedicated to offering quality, direct-from-provider care to every patient.

Before opening the Payson Walk-In Clinic, Borak served the area at the Tonto-Apache Clinic for three years. Before that, he served as a U.S. Marshal for 25 years.

While walk-ins are accepted, providers offer service depending on their availability. And those with appointments are given priority.

Without an insurance company dictating care and treatment options, patients can get just the care needed when it's needed, he said.

Borak founded the clinic with a commitment to provide a higher level of care, that allows patients to improve and maintain their health

without the stress that prolongs the process.

Payson Walk-In Clinic offers same-day healthcare with the following general primary care services:

- Preventative care, exams, screenings, referrals
- Flu, cold, sore throat, sinus congestion, eye infections, ear aches
- Nausea, acid reflux, diarrhea, constipation, urinary tract infections
- Fever, COVID, headaches, seasonal allergies, asthma
- Sprains, back pain, joint pain injections, sores and rashes, insect bites
- High cholesterol, high blood pressure, men's health

The testing and medications provided in-house and their cost include:

- On-Site Testing – Blood Glucose – Free; Urinalysis – Free; COVID – \$19; Flu – \$19; Strep – \$9
- \$9 Medications – Antibiotics (Azithromycin, Amoxicillin, Cephalaxin, Doxycycline, Clindamycin, Bactrim); Antinausea (Zofran); Headache (Sumatriptan Injection); Flu (Oseltamivir/Tamiflu);

Yeast infection (Fluconazole); Cough (Tessalon Perles); Musculoskeletal (Toradol injection, Flexeril, Ibuprofen 800mg); Skin/rash (topicals-Hydrocortisone, nystatin); B-12 Injection 1000mcg; UTI (Pyridium); Kidney Stones (Tamsulosin)

- \$19 Medications; Eye (Erythromycin ointment, Polymyxin B Sulfate-Trimethoprim drops); Albuterol Breathing TreatmentsKenalog – Allergy Shot
- ED Medications – \$9 per month (Sildenafil 100mg “Viagra” #10Tadalafil 5mg or 10mg “Cialis” #30)

An office visit is \$59 and includes an exam and treatment, with basic tests included.
